<b>BRICC Drivers</b>	Ensuring the safe and timely transport of BRICC and other cancer patients to their appointments, then returning them home in a Grampians Health fleet vehicle	Currently Operational
<b>BRICC Wellness Centre</b>	Providing a quality, person focused service to the community, assisting patients and their families to navigate the relevant parts of BRICC, including the services on offer within the Centre to the patients undergoing treatment	Currently Operational
